For controlling mini ring (*Waitea zaeae*) or take-all root rot (*Gaeumannomyces* spp.) over smaller areas where outbreaks are severe or expected to become severe. To make a curative spot treatment, apply 3.8 fl oz of Trefinti nematicide/fungicide per 10,000 sq ft and repeat up to 4 times a year or apply 7.6 fl oz per 10,000 sq ft and repeat up to 2 times a year at the prescribed intervals. For curative spot treatments, treat no more than 10,000 sq ft per acre per year. Watering in with 0.125 to 0.250 inches of irrigation directly after application is recommended.
